

PACIFIC NORTHWEST Chapter 31 NAWCC

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this organization shall be: The Pacific-Northwest Chapter 31 of The National Association of Watch and Clock Collectors, Incorporated, and shall subsequently be referred to as the Association.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSES

The purposes of this association shall be: (A) To stimulate interest in timepieces of all kinds; (B) To foster genuine interest in collecting timepieces; (C) To facilitate the sale or purchases of timepieces by members; (D) To cooperate with individuals and with other organizations in exhibiting timepieces; (E) To collect and preserve horological data and material for posterity; (F) To disseminate full information regarding the mechanism of timepieces and the repair thereof.

ARTICLE III. NON-PROFIT

This Association shall be a non-profit organization of horologists and collectors of timepieces and/or horological material.

ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS

The officers of this Association shall consist of: a President, a Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The offices of Secretary and Treasurer may not be combined in one person.

ARTICLE V. COUNCIL

There shall be four Directors, and these with the Officers, and the Immediate Past President, shall constitute the Council of this Association.

ARTICLE VI. ELIGIBILITY

Any person or institution is eligible for membership subject to the conditions defined in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VII. BYLAWS

The Association shall, by the enactment of suitable Bylaws, provide for the election of officers, the length of terms, the election of members, the place and conduct of meetings, the amount of dues, and such other matters as may be necessary or desirable.

The Bylaws shall contain nothing inconsistent with this Constitution.

ARTICLE VIII. AMENDMENTS

Amendments may be made only by the membership entitled to vote. All balloting shall be by secret ballot through use of the United States mail. All members shall be sent a ballot and a two-thirds affirmative vote in the ballots returned shall be necessary to change the Constitution.
