Approval of Minutes – The May minutes approved as published in the TimeOut

Treasurer's Report – Betty Chisum was ill, however her Treasurer's report presented at the June 12th Council meeting was used. We continue to be solvent.

Membership Report – John Bailey reported we have 81 members. John introduced Rod Lloyd of St. Helen's who is a new member. John & his wife Merry attended the Spokane Regional and are looking forward to participating in the 2011 Regional.
