The Purchase and Restoration of a Japanese Automon by Mearl Snell.

The Japanese Automon began about 5000 years ago as a complex wooden puppet appearing once a year at festivals. The clock mechanism was introduced in Japan during the late 1600's. Soon after the clock mechanisms were integrated into the puppets allowing precise movements. The complex mechanical

puppets can change shapes, for example from man to animal or spirit, or perform precise human motions such as serving tea to a guest seated across the table and return.

This automan is the most sophisticated in Japan, and invented by the founder of Mitsubishi Inc. He is also the premier clock-smith in the 19th century.
