Dead Beat Escapement vs. Anchor Escapement by Henry Casson. You will be seeing a presentation made by Jonathan Betts to the British Horological Institute South London Branch on November 4, 2010. Jonathan is Senior Curator of Horology at the Royal Observatory in Greenwich, England. 
