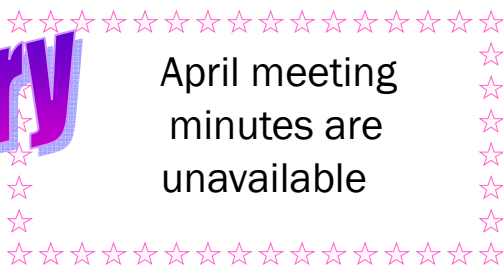
Board Meeting Minutes:
