**OTHER NEWS:** This past year, George Matto presented a program to Chapter 31 on the Antikythera, an ancient mechanical astronomical position calculator, thought to be built around 150-100 B.C. Modern technology was used to peer deep into the ocean-encrusted mechanism, seeing the finely cut gears. George contacted Dr. Tony Freeth, one of the research leaders unraveling this 2,000-year-old mechanical device. Through his communications, he found that Dr Freeth published a booklet on this ancient device available at a museum bookstore in England.

George began a dialog between Diana DeLucca editor of the NAWCC Bulletin, and Dr. Freeth gaining permission to reprint his booklet. As a result of George's communications, Dr. Freeth generous sharing of his publication, and re-print release from the museum, the February 2010 issue of The Bulletin will present Dr. Freeth work.

For this, Chapter 31 will be presenting Dr. Freeth with a membership in the National Association of Watch and Clock Collectors. And, special thanks to George; our chapter thanks you!
